

MacOS Eduroam Connection User Guide

1. To check the version of your MacOS computer, click on "About This Mac" from the "Apple Menu" in the upper left corner and check the version. If your version is 10.7 and above, follow the steps below. If not, see other guides. (Figure 1, Figure 2)



2. Click on the Wi-Fi menu from the top right of your PC and select the "eduroam_setup" network. (Figure 3)



3. After connecting to the "eduroam_setup" network, you will be automatically directed to "eduroam.bogazici.edu.tr". If the redirection does not occur, you can access the relevant page by typing "eduroam.bogazici.edu.tr/en" into the address bar of your Safari browser. (Figure 4)

4. On the newly opened page, click on the link to download the configuration file under the "Mac OS X 10.7 or higher" menu. (Figure 5)



5. In order to install the downloaded profile, Open the "Settings" and click on the "Continue" button on the screen that appears. (Figure 6). Then click on the "Continue" button again on the next screen. (Figure 7)



6. On the "Enterprise Network" login screen, enter your Boğaziçi University e-mail address and password and click the "Install" button. (Figure 8)

7. When the profile installation is completed, make sure that your profile settings look like the one below. (Figure 9)

8. Then, you can successfully connect to eduroam by selecting the “eduroam” network from the Wi-Fi menu. (Figure 10)



NOT: If you enter your **username** on the profile setup windows, you can benefit from the eduroam service in **only our university**. In order to use this service **in all other universities** which have the eduroam network, you must enter your **email address** with the extension "**@bogazici.edu.tr**" instead of just username.
